SHOULD OUR SONS be forced into an army that is breaking the Geneva Agreements by being in Vietnam?

The Geneva Agreement on the Cessation of Hostilities in Vietnam, 20/7/1954, Article 16, states:

"With effect from the date of entry into force of the present agreement, the introduction into Vietnam of any troop reinforcements and additional military personnel is prohibited."

Declaration by the Representative of the U.S.A., Under-Secretary Walter Bedell Smith, at the signing of the Agreements:

"The Government of the United States declares with regard to the aforesaid agreements . . . it will refrain from the threat or the use of force to disturb them, in accordance with Article 2(4) of the Charter of the United Nations . . ."

At the direction of our Government Australian army troops (soon to include conscripts) are fighting on the side of the anti-democratic, pro-fascist South Vietnamese Premier, Air Vice-Marshal Ky, who said in an interview (London Sunday Mirror, July 4, 1965):

"People ask me who my heroes are. I have only one — Hitler."

Many fathers of today's conscripts fought against Hitler and what he stood for.
