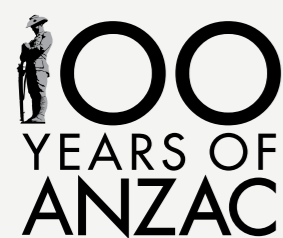


Remembrance Day

IN NOVEMBER 1914 A CONVOY OF SHIPS FROM THE ROYAL AUSTRALIAN NAVY, NEW ZEALAND, BRITAIN AND JAPAN, DEPARTED FROM ALBANY IN WESTERN AUSTRALIA CARRYING 30,000 TROOPS WHO WOULD BECOME THE FIRST ANZACS, BOUND FOR SERVICE IN THE FIRST WORLD WAR. EN ROUTE, HMAS SYDNEY SANK THE GERMAN RAIDER *EMDEN*, ENSURING SAFE PASSAGE THROUGH THE INDIAN OCEAN.
