

# Topic 2: Impressions of war

## Work Sheet 2E: Impressions of World War II – Activity Table

Study the sources of evidence for World War II on *Source Sheet 2D* and using the information provided in each, complete the table on the next page.

Use the web address provided with each source to find more information about the source and the people and events it depicts.

**Type of source:** State whether it is a photograph, painting, eyewitness account, newspaper report etc.

**Brief description of contents:** For example eyewitness account of Japanese kamikaze attack on Australian ship.

**Perspective:** Identify the person or organisation who produced the source, eg soldier, sailor, war photographer, artist and indicate the person's name if known.

**Theatre of war:** Such as Pacific war against Japan (Philippines, Malaya, New Guinea, etc.), North Africa (Alamein, Tobruk, Bardia), Crete.

**Branch of defence force:** Which of the following is the source about: AIF (army), RAN (navy), RAAF (air force), etc.

**Main idea or message conveyed:** Briefly state what you consider to be the main idea or purpose of the source (eg consider who produced the source, their purpose and their target audience).
