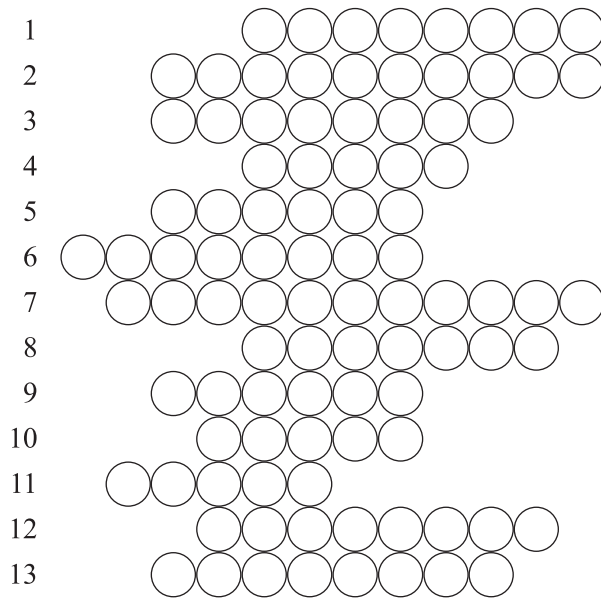


Topic 10: Commemoration
