### **BUGLE CALLS**

#### The Last Post

The Last Post is a bugle call played before the period of silence at a commemorative service.

#### Reveille

At a dawn service on Anzac Day, *Reveille* is played on a bugle or trumpet and signals the end of the period of silence. During the bugle being played, the flags are slowly raised to the mast head.

Historically, *Reveille* was played to wake up sleeping soldiers on the battlefield. Today, *Reveille* is played as the first call of the day in army barracks.

#### The Rouse

The Rouse is a bugle call that is played after the period of silence at a ceremony other than a dawn service. During *The Rouse*, the flags are slowly raised to the mast head.

Historically, *The Rouse* was played after *Reveille* to get soldiers out of their beds. The use of *The Rouse* in a ceremony implies hope for a day when the living and the dead will rise together.

## **HYMNS**

*O Valiant Hearts* is a hymn of remembrance inspired by a poem published after the First World War to commemorate those who died.

**Abide with Me** is a hymn that asks for God to remain by your side throughout life and death.

*Our God, Our Help in Ages Past* is a hymn that asks God for protection.

## **NATIONAL ANTHEMS**

When the *Australian National Anthem* is played in conjunction with the national anthem of a foreign country, the foreign country's national anthem is always played first.
